
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How is it funded?

COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION & THE NDIS

Community Participation is funded for NDIS participant's who have the Assistance with Social, Economic and Community **Participation** budget category included in their NDIS Plan. Funding for community participation is included to cover costs of additional supports you many need to participation in activities.

Does my NDIS Plan cover the cost of activities?

No, you'll still need to pay for the general costs of your social and recreation activities. These are costs that everyone has to pay for.

This means you will pay for things like membership, basic equipment or entrance fees. Depending on your individual needs you might have one or both types of funding in your NDIS plan.







What sort of activities can I do?


CHOICES, CHOICES.
